



Screening Questions

(May 1, 2020)

We are asking all our Patients a few questions for your own safety and the safety of other Patients and Staff.

1. How are you feeling? Do you have any symptoms of fever, cough, sore throat, or shortness of breath?

2. Have you had close contact with a person confirmed to have the COVID-19 in the last 14 days?

3. Have you personally had COVID-19? If so, have you been released by your physician to return to regular activities?

4. Have you been told by a public health official that you may have been exposed to COVID-19 in the last 14 days?

If the answer is yes to any of the questions, please recommend they consult with their doctor and reschedule their appointment in 14 days. Let them know an earlier return is ok if an alternate diagnosis to explain fever/symptoms (ex: flu), but that they must be without symptoms for at least two days before returning.

Let them know that you care about them and their safety. Offer telehealth as another option to continue their plan of care. Contact their referral source to let them know of the delay.

If anyone is known to have COVID-19, they must stay home for 14 days and without symptoms before returning.
